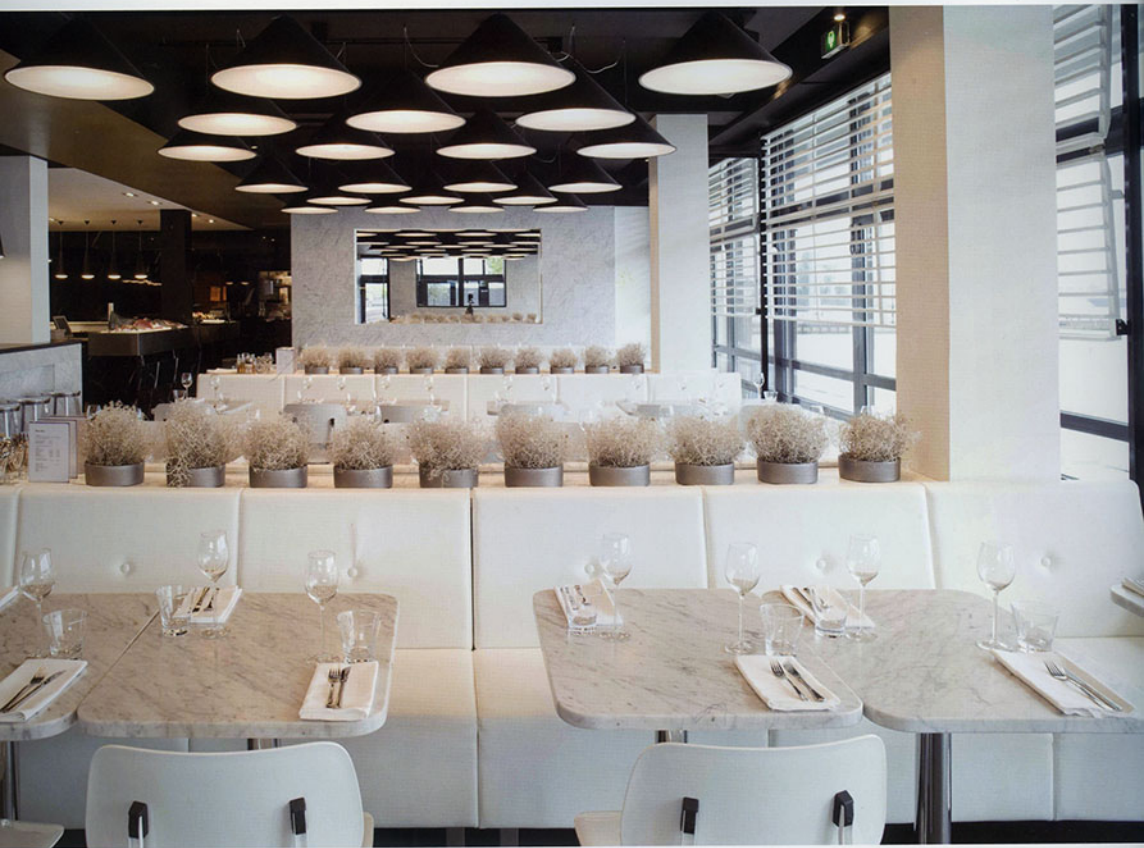

Concrete was asked to redesign the formerly known restaurant Orass. The restaurant is a new member in the succession of two existing restaurants: delicacy restaurant "envy" and wine bar "vyne". The facility for this location is a fish restaurant called "nevy".

Concrete created tranquillity by eliminating all unnecessary elements. The basic of the design concept is to create a space, which has the appearance of an old market hall. Marble was therefore a forehand choice.

The restaurant consists of two parts, the restaurant and the raw bar. To create a visual separation between the two parts black and white are chosen. In the white part, the ceiling and floor are black. The opposite appears in the black area. There you see a white floor and ceiling.
